We also had a good turn out for a meeting held at Blair Adam forest were we where joined by the Pitcairn Volunteers to help survey the site for amphibian friendly ponds. Here, ½ dozen new ponds were mapped and so proved a good starting block to begin working along side the forestry commission to increase the numbers of amphibians in the area. Again much recruiting was carried out by our 'press-gang' operative!! With great success as we now have approx 20 members. We also discovered Water Voles which is a new record for Fife. Over the past 12 months, we have managed to secure 2 lots of funding for the group which will pay for materials and for a number of projects. Hopefully new licenses will be with the founding members soon which will allow a greater involvement and discoveries.
